Dear Parents/Carers,

As we reach the end of our first full week back with the children, Autumn has definitely set in and the summer holidays seem like a distant memory!!

The children have all started this year the calmest any of the teachers can remember; we are so proud of them and how they are upholding our school values, of being Proud, Resilient and Respectful. Please see below for details of what they have been learning this week.

Next week, the new EYFS children will be able to come to breakfast club and after school club, please book via the link sent today and pay in advance.

Yesterday, the links for the Argyle sporting after school clubs were sent out: EYFS, Yr1, Yr2 and Yr3 can do multi skills on Monday; Yrs 3-6 can do football on a Thursday. Both clubs run from 3.15 until 4.15. If you are entitled to Free School Meals, it is only £1 a week, and if not it is only £2 a week, these are much cheaper than any clubs in other schools. Foundation & Year 1: Year 1 have quickly settled back into school routine and have been welcoming and supportive to the new foundation children that have joined us. Foundation have settled well and enjoyed trying school dinners this week. The children have been busy in our continuous provision engaging in fun activities such as using loose parts to create funny faces, using paint and collage techniques to make their own faces, and acting out Goldilocks and the 3 Bears.



Year 2: For our art lesson this week, Year 2/3 were learning about how artists are often collectors and explorers. We thought about places we spend time and generated ideas as to what may be collected in each location. We considered how both natural and man-made objects can be used to create art. We completed our work in our new garden area.





Year 3: What a super first full week the class have had! The class have settled in well to the new routines of the class and have shown how mature and responsible they can be. In history, we've started to discuss our new topic on Ancient Egypt and have talked about the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb and the riches that were found. In maths, we've started to learn about place value and partitioning numbers. The Year 3 team have been impressed with how well and quickly the children are learning the new information. Well done!



Year 4: This week year 4 have been getting used to their routines and impressing me with their incredible hard work. We have been learning about the difference between formal and informal language and looking at the organisational features of a non fiction text.

WHAT THE NEW RULES MEAN FOR ME

1 I'm a single parent of one child and we want to go on holiday for a week.

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything. Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine. The fine is £160 but if you pay it in 21 days it will be reduced to £80.

2 FOR EVERY CHILD A PENALTY IS GIVEN.

IRREGULAR ATTENDANCE
10 IN 10 **5**

If your child is absent for 10 or more sessions in 10 weeks and their absences are unauthorised. The school will consider prosecution.

1 Day = **2** Sessions

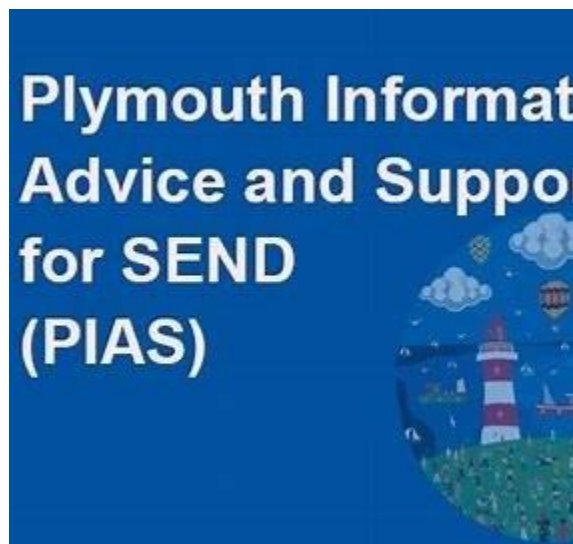
