Dear parents/carers,

The first half term is done! What a varied week we have had with the weather: rain, sun, rain, sun and it was lovely to end with a mainly sunny day.

We started this week by celebrating our Harvest festival and our generosity for the Plymouth foodbank. Reverend Ann took our Harvest assembly; she rearranged the letters of HARVEST to make different words, the most important one being SHARE. Rachel from the Foodbank was really impressed by the amount of our donations and our willingness to share what we have. This was the 1st act of kindness for

our 9 Acts of Kindness Challenge; the children have also completed another act of kindness this week by colouring their bunting to decorate childrens' wards in hospitals across the region. Two acts done, seven to go...this will continue after half term. When they have completed 8 acts of kindness, you are invited to donate some money to Childline as the 9th act of kindness in the week beginning 6.11.23.



Foundation: this week we have been learning the sounds r, j, v, y and w. We have been trying out some vocabulary from our story including gloomy, slithering and vast. We have also been painting autumn trees using autumn colours.



Year 1: we have been adding a new character to our story and thinking about what the character could do to make Claire hurt her knee. We have also been extending our sentences with the word 'and'. In science we have been exploring all the signs of autumn and noticing how we have less sunlight during autumn and winter.



Year 2: have made their fruit salads using all the skills they learnt in their Design and Technology lessons. They cut a variety of fruit they had chosen and then enjoyed eating their final product.



Year 3: the children have been finishing their learning about Hinduism and the story of Rama and Sita. The children have really enjoyed this unit, please ask talk to your child about their knowledge of the story, I think you will be amazed!

Year 4/5: we have been learning about how good overcomes evil in the story of Rama and Sita and thinking about the word 'dharma' and how each character in the story follows their dharma. I have been so impressed by their brilliant contributions to the class discussions. Well done 4/5 - keep up the super work.



Year 6: this week we have finished our units in History, Geography and RE. We have enjoyed all of these but particularly enjoyed the RE unit learning about the Hindu story, Rama and Sita. The children have been discussing that they have learned SO much and can really see how the story links to how Hindus celebrate today. In Maths, we have displayed pure resilience to secure our learning on long division – a really tricky Year 6 concept.




Dress up for Halloween - 31/10/2023

Attendance.

Every moment in school counts, and days missed add up quickly. The higher a child's attendance, the more they are likely to learn, and the better they are likely to perform in exams and formal assessments. We are implementing new procedures to help parents get their children to school.

Do you know your child's attendance ?

95% Attendance - 2 whole weeks of school missed.

90% Attendance - 4 whole weeks of school missed.

85% Attendance - 6 whole weeks of school missed.

80% Attendance - 8 whole weeks of school missed.

75% Attendance - 9 plus whole weeks of school missed.

5 minutes late, does it really matter ?



Lateness = Lost Learning

(Figures below are calculated over a school year)

- **5** Minutes late each day - **3** days lost
- **10** Minutes late each day - **6.5** days lost
- **15** Minutes late each day - **10** days lost

- 20 Minutes late each day - 13 days lost
- 30 Minutes late each day - 19 days lost
